

# A guide to sorting your waste



## General waste

- Plastic bottles
- Paper
- Glass
- Metal
- Wrappers from snacks
- Food waste

Put the waste in a bag  
Tie with a knot.



## Glass

- Glass bottles from spirits, dressing and fruit juice
- Marmalade/jam glasses
- Empty food jars
- Wine bottles

Place empty glass  
and bottles loose in the container.



## Paper

- Newspapers and magazines
- Letters and envelopes
- Writing paper
- Brochures



Must be clean and dry.  
Place loose in the container.

## Food waste

- Food waste, raw and cooked
- Fruit and vegetables
- Egg- and nutshells
- Tea bags, coffee filters and coffee ground
- Kitchen paper and napkins



Put the waste  
in a green bag - tie with a knot.

## Metal

- Tins from beer and soft drinks
- Food tins
- Aluminum trays and foil
- Used tea light holders, bottle tops and metal lids



Place the empty  
packaging loose in the container.

## Cardboard

- Small cardboard boxes
- Thin cardboard packaging
- Corrugated cardboard
- Shoe boxes
- Egg boxes



Must be clean and dry.  
Place loose in the container.

## Food- & drink cartons

- Empty cartons from milk and juice
- Empty food cartons i.e. from soup, yoghurt, creme and ice cream



Put the empty packaging loose  
in the container

## Plastic

- Plastic trays from cakes, fruit and vegetables
- Plastic foil e.g. carrier bags, freezer bags
- Plastic containers



Put the empty packaging  
loose in the container

## Hazardous waste

- Small electronic devices
- Poison for plants and pesticides
- Paint and oil residues
- Batteries
- Spray bottles
- Chemicals
- Thermometers
- Light bulbs



## To be delivered at the recycling centers

### Other types of waste

- White goods
- Furniture
- Carpets
- Electronics
- Large cardboard boxes
- Textile waste
- Garden waste
